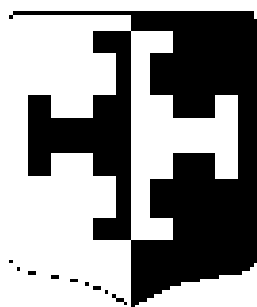

## **PE & Sport at St.Chad's CE Primary School**

At St.Chad's C.E. Primary School, we recognise and value the importance of PE and the impact high quality PE has on our pupil's health and wellbeing. To achieve this we have been given Sports Premium funding provided by the Government.

### **What is the Sports Premium funding?**

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. Each school will receive £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil equates to nearly £9,000 a year. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

### **Vision for PE & Sport**

Our vision for 2015-16 is :

To increase the quality of PE in our school through; development of teacher's knowledge and confidence, engaging with the expertise of club leaders in the local community and promoting physical activity.

### **How have we chosen to spend the budget to achieve our vision?**

From discussions with staff and children and evaluating our PE provision, we identified the following areas for development:

Staff CPD – Following a staff survey it was evident that some staff felt they needed additional training to enable them to deliver the highest quality PE sessions. Through the Active Schools programme identified staff were sent on PE courses to develop their own knowledge, skills and understanding, they were then asked to cascade to the wider team during staff development sessions. All staff received REAL PE training during our Spring term training day.

Curriculum – The school invested in a new scheme of work for gymnastics and the resources and training to support its implementation.

Subject Leader Development – To enable the PE subject leader to keep up-to-date with developments in PE and sport and to ensure they continue to update their skills we participated in the Active Schools Subject Leader Development Programme.

Bespoke sports programmes – To enhance the sports and competitive events we offer our pupils a number of after school and in-school activities were provided e.g. KS2 basketball day at the local university.

Transport – To enable pupils to get to and from sporting venues monies were allocated to support this.
